

Punjab to set up agriculture bureau

» In its bid to provide single window system to farmers for accelerating agriculture growth in the state, Punjab government will set up a 'Bureau of Agriculture Promotion'.

"Chief Minister Parkash Singh Badal has given the nod to constitute 'Bureau of Agriculture Promotion' in the state," an official spokesman said on Tuesday.
